

The atmospheric and historic Merikortteli is a unique property in the heart of the maritime Punavuori.

Built in 1920, the six-floor Merikortteli covers an entire block in Punavuori. It was built mainly for industrial use, but was later renovated into modern, high-quality offices and workspaces, without touching its prestigious history.

Located at Pursimiehenkatu 29-31, the building is home to a diverse range of businesses, from coffee roasters to advertising agencies, which together form a unique and vibrant working community.






Merikortteli was the first modern industrial building in Finland. The protected building is surrounded by an energetic urban landscape.



Offering a unique space, the clear structure of Merikortteli makes it easy and flexible to design different floor plans. The room heights (3-5 meters) of the open spaces are exceptionally high. The large windows, flooded with natural light, offer a magnificent view of the surrounding landscape: the beautiful historic buildings and the lively streetscape of Punavuori. There are many restaurants nearby and the Hietalahti market hall is just around the corner. The seaside is also just a stone's throw away.









When companies rent premises from Merikortteli, they get more than just a physical space for their operations: they become part of a large shared working community.


Many of the businesses in Merikortteli are engaged in mutually beneficial cooperation and networking.

The adaptability of the premises available for rent in Merikortteli has allowed the company's premises to evolve as the business grows. Merikortteli has been home to several major Finnish companies, including ABB, Kone and Nokia. The story goes that Nokia's decision to enter the electronics sector was made when the company was located in Merikortteli.



Punavuori's vibrant streetscape has a communal and homely feel, just like Merikortteli.

Merikortteli is surrounded by a lively environment, with Helsinki's beautiful southern coastline, numerous services and the harbour nearby. In addition to restaurants and cafés, the cozy district offers small brick-and-mortar shops and other services. In Merikortteli there is an Alepa and two popular cafés. Its central location ensures that Merikortteli is easily accessible by tram and bus. The nearest bus stop is right next by. For those travelling by car, parking space is provided by the property's parking garage and the 180 parking spaces in the courtyard. The train station is less than 2 km away and Helsinki-Vantaa airport is 30 minutes away.






Merikortteli

Merikortteli is located at Pursimiehenkatu 29-31, right in the heart of Punavuori. Merikorttelti's premises are easily adaptable and suitable for a wide range of office needs. Tenants can also develop their premises as their business grows - saving them the need to move.

The central location ensures that Merikortteli is easily accessible by tram and bus. The nearest bus stop is right next to Merikortteli. For those travelling by car, parking space is provided by the building's parking garage and courtyard parking spaces. Punavuori is a pleasant and lively area, with plenty of restaurants and cafés nearby, as well as the Riviera cinema in the same building. Kaivopuisto and Eira beach are also within walking distance.




